- Ensure a rigorous, standards-based instructional program that is geared towards enabling all students to meet the challenges of the future with confidence and compassion.



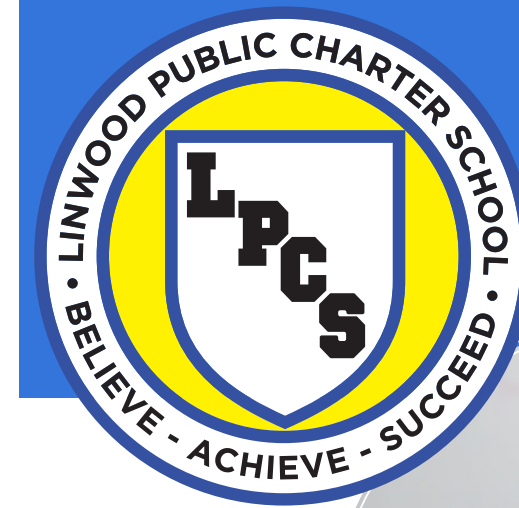
