LINWOOD PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL SESSION INFORMATION

Session 1: Parenting 101: Structure, Routines, & Consistency

The aim of this course is understanding how structure, routines, and consistency are essential concepts to effective parenting.

Session 2A: Single Parenting

In this course, attendees will learn first-hand from a mother and grandmother who successfully raised five children alone, after the death of her husband.

Session 2B: Co-Parenting

This session will provide a brief overview of possible challenges experienced while navigating co-parenting relationships.

Session 3: Children & the Law

Session 4: Mental Health
