It costs nothing to be grateful and kind. When your little one is at home, encourage them to use the words "please" and "thank you." For example, every time your little needs something, look to see if they began their request with, "May I ____, please?" and that they end the request by saying, "Thank you." Also, look to see if your child uses age-appropriate words and actions. Do they do what they said they would? Words without action do not mean anything.

TRANSPORTATION

Dear Parents,
